

## Road renamed for former village clerk

Islandia officials have renamed a road in honor of longtime Village Court Clerk Linda Sheahan.

Sheahan was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2008 and died of the disease in 2014.

She and her family lived on Silverleaf Lane for more than 35 years, and Mayor Allan Dorman said renaming her block was a good way to honor the woman who had also served as deputy village clerk and deputy registrar. Her sister Marilyn Griffaton is the current village deputy clerk.

“We came up with an idea to remember her and get her some recognition for her service,” Dorman said. “It was a recognition of someone who was very faithful to her village and did a lot of community service. She was a good person, a great person to know.”

The village held a dedication ceremony Aug. 12 to unveil the new sign for Linda R. Sheahan Lane.
